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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Legislative Objectives

The proposed ordinance re-appropriates \$650,000 as follows: (a) \$400,000 from General City Responsibility to District 7 Participatory Budgeting projects (\$300,000) and to the City Administrator for District 7 Disaster Planning (\$100,000); and (b) \$250,000 in the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) budget to Vision Zero projects in District 7.

Key Points

- The Board of Supervisors previously appropriated \$400,000 to General City Responsibility for District 7 Participatory Budgeting projects, and \$250,000 to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) for Vision Zero projects in District 7.

Fiscal Impact

- The proposed ordinance appropriates funds to the: Department of Public Works streetscape and other improvements (\$105,000); Department of Children, Youth and Families for summer programs and school site improvements (\$75,000); SFMTA for Vision Zero and other projects (\$295,000); Police for crime prevention (\$25,000); San Francisco Public Utilities Commission for pathway improvements (\$20,000); Office of Economic and Workforce Development for West Portal events (\$25,000); Library for Ingleside Library family activities (\$5,000), and City Administrator for disaster preparedness projects (\$100,000).

Recommendation

- Approve the proposed ordinance.

MANDATE STATEMENT

City Charter Section 9.105 states that amendments to the Annual Appropriations Ordinance, after the Controller certifies the availability of funds, are subject to Board of Supervisors approval by ordinance.

BACKGROUND

The Board of Supervisors previously appropriated \$400,000 to General City Responsibility for District 7 Participatory Budgeting projects, and \$250,000 to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) for Vision Zero projects in District 7.

DETAILS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

The proposed ordinance re-appropriates \$650,000 as follows: (a) \$400,000 from General City Responsibility to District 7 Participatory Budgeting projects (\$300,000) and to the City Administrator for District 7 Disaster Planning (\$100,000); and (b) \$250,000 in the SFMTA budget to Vision Zero projects in District 7.


