

Queens SF, LLC located at 1235 9th Avenue San Francisco, CA 94122 is requesting a determination for Public Convenience of Necessity (PCN) for our type 20 ABC license (person to person and premise to premise transfer). Our business hours are Mondays and Tuesdays (8am to 4 pm) and Wednesdays thru Sundays (8am to 8 pm).

We filed the application for the type 20 license on August 8th, 2019 at the ABC office on 33 New Montgomery Street, San Francisco, CA 94105. We posted our Public Notice on August 12th, 2019 and mailed out our 500 foot radius mailings on August 23rd, 2019.






