

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**
3 **REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON 4th STREET BETWEEN**
4 **BRYANT STREET AND BRANNAN STREET.**

5 **WHEREAS**, On February 15, 2000, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency sewer
6 condition on 4th Street between Bryant Street and Brannan Street; and

7 **WHEREAS**, The existing 3' x 5' brick sewer located on 4th Street between Bryant Street and
8 Brannan Street had collapsed, resulting in ground settlement, sand infiltration, and multiple hidden voids
9 throughout the entire block; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Immediate repairs and sewer replacement were required in order to protect the
11 health, welfare, and property of the Public; and

12 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Clean
13 Water Program Contract No. CW-274E, "4th Street Emergency Sewer Replacement," to replace the
14 existing sewer with approximately 600 feet of 42-inch diameter Hobas fiberglass pipe sewer and 42 feet
15 of 12-inch diameter no-dig vitrified clay pipe sewer; and

16 **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is projected to be \$542,540.00, of which \$447,890.00 is for
17 the construction contract; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Funds are available from the 1995B Sewer Bond under Job Order No. 0140J (Fund
19 5C/CPF/95B, FAMIS Project No. CEN95BSI01); and

20 **WHEREAS**, The Contractor, D'Arcy & Harty Construction, Inc., began the emergency work on
21 March 2, 2000 and all work should be completed by March 28, 2000; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Because this is an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals are not required;
23 and

24 **WHEREAS**, The Planning Department's Major Environmental Analysis Section has determined
25 the Clean Water Program's sewer replacement program to be categorically exempt from environmental

1 review under the State Guidelines implementing the California Environmental Quality Act; and

2 **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section
3 6.60 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an
4 emergency; now, therefore, be it

5 **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the
6 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on 4th Street between Bryant Street and
7 Brannan Street.




