

1 [Approval of a contract amendment with InfoMc, Inc. to support and maintain the
2 eCURA application in use by the Community Behavioral Health Services unit of the
3 Department of Public Health.]
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6 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to enter
7 into a contract amendment with InfoMc, Inc. for the continued maintenance of
8 proprietary InfoMc, Inc. applications for a new term July 1, 1999 through June 30, 2011.
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10 WHEREAS, DPH has entered into a prior licensing Agreement with InfoMc as the
11 principal vendor for mental health billing software known as the cCURA / eCURA
12 products; and
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14 WHEREAS, The Health Commission, and has previously approved the proposed
15 contract for this system; and
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17 WHEREAS, the proposed contract handles over \$49 million dollars of revenue
18 for the Department, and assists the Department to effectively bill for mental health
19 services; and
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21 WHEREAS, DPH is in the process of transitioning to a new suite of applications
22 to take over these services; and
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24 WHEREAS, the cost of said contract, would not exceed Two Million Nine
25 Hundred Eighty One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,981,250); the

1 modification will however, require the City and County of San Francisco to enter into
2 an agreement in excess of ten years; and

4 WHEREAS, Section SEC. 9.118.B of the San Francisco Charter requires that
5 such contracts be approved by the Board of Supervisors; and now, therefore; be it

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7 RESOLVED, that DPH that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the
8 Director of Public Health and the Office of Contract Administration, on behalf of the City
9 and County of San Francisco, to a contract amendment between the City and County of
10 San Francisco and InfoMc, Inc. as set forth in File No. 080675 for the period July 1,
11 1999 though June 30, 2011
