WHEREAS, This proposed anti-gay legislation also will contribute to intolerance, divisiveness and hate and even encourage hate crimes against members of the gay community throughout California; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Archdiocese of San Francisco and other archdiocese of California to withdraw financial contributions in support of the Knight Initiative; and let it be

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors encourages the Archdiocese to pastor to its lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender parishioners.
