WHEREAS, DPH is the recipient of a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs in the amount of \$200,000 to conduct the SF AllM Higher project, for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, The SF AIIM (Assess, Identify Needs, Integrate Information, and Match to Services) Higher program will serve a total of 400 youth with moderate to serious risks and mental health needs at San Francisco's Juvenile Justice Center and the Log Cabin Ranch; and,

WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH for one existing position for the period of September 1, 2008 through August 31, 2010, at .70 FTE to be filled by either a Psychiatric Social Worker (Job Class #2930) or a Marriage, Family, & Child Counselor (Job Class #2931); and,

WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not receive the award letter and agreement from the funder until September 2, 2008 with a project start date of September 1, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, The budget does include matching funds in the amount of \$50,000, or \$25,000 per year, an in-kind contribution of facility expenses and personnel costs; and,

WHEREAS, The budget does not include a provision for indirect costs because the U.S. Department of Justice does not allow it; now therefore, be it
