3 **Resolution commending Ming Pao Daily News’ San Francisco edition for five years of**
4 **service to the Chinese-American community in the San Francisco Bay Area.**

6 WHEREAS, Ming Pao Daily News’ San Francisco edition launched in April 2004, and
7 offered readers information on local news happening in the Bay Area, as well as
8 internationally in China and Taiwan; and,

10 WHEREAS, Ming Pao San Francisco strove to operate on the principle of maintaining
11 high journalistic standards in addressing social, political and business issues in both local and
12 international arenas; and,

13 WHEREAS, As delivering news through the Internet became more prominent, Ming
14 Pao San Francisco launched a news website in June 2006, providing full versions of Ming
15 Pao San Francisco in electronic version, helping to better serve the community with breaking
16 news and the latest information; and,

17 WHEREAS, Ming Pao San Francisco launched MP Free News in January 2007, a free
18 newspaper distributed at more than 200 locations that helped to bridge and serve more
19 Chinese-Americans; and,

20 WHEREAS, Ming Pao San Francisco won the 2006 Northern California Chinese Media
21 Association Best News Photographer award and jointly won the 2005 Northern California
22 Chinese Media Association Best TV Commentary Award with World Channel; and,

23 WHEREAS, On February 15, 2009, Ming Pao ceased its San Francisco edition based
24 in San Francisco after five years on the newsstands; now, therefore, be it
