3 **Resolution extending the life of the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force.**

5 WHEREAS, On May 4, 2007 The San Francisco Planning Commission removed
6 Western SoMa from the Eastern Neighborhoods rezoning process and declared that the
7 zoning of western SoMa would not be considered again until the area had undergone a
8 comprehensive community-based planning process; and,

9 WHEREAS, On December 1, 2004 the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution
10 #041359 establishing the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force for a period of 3 years;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, On April 11, 2008 the Board of Supervisors passed Resolution #150-08
13 extending the life of the Task Force to June 30, 2009; and

14 WHEREAS, The draft Western SoMa Community Plan was presented to the South of
15 Market community at a Town Hall meeting on April 23, 2008; and

16 WHEREAS, The draft Western SoMa Community Plan was presented to the Planning
17 Commission on September 18, 2008, initiating a series of public hearings and environment
18 review; and

19 WHEREAS, The draft Western SoMa Community Plan was unanimously endorsed by
20 the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task Force on October 22, 2008; and

21 WHEREAS, The draft Western SoMa Community Plan was presented to the Land Use
22 and Economic Development Committee of the Board of Supervisors on April 20, 2009; and

23 WHEREAS, There is an ongoing need for the Western SoMa Citizens Planning Task
24 Force to complete its recommendations to the Planning Department and the Board of
25 Supervisors on current rezoning efforts; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends the life of the Western SoMa
2 Citizens Planning Task Force until June 30, 2010.
