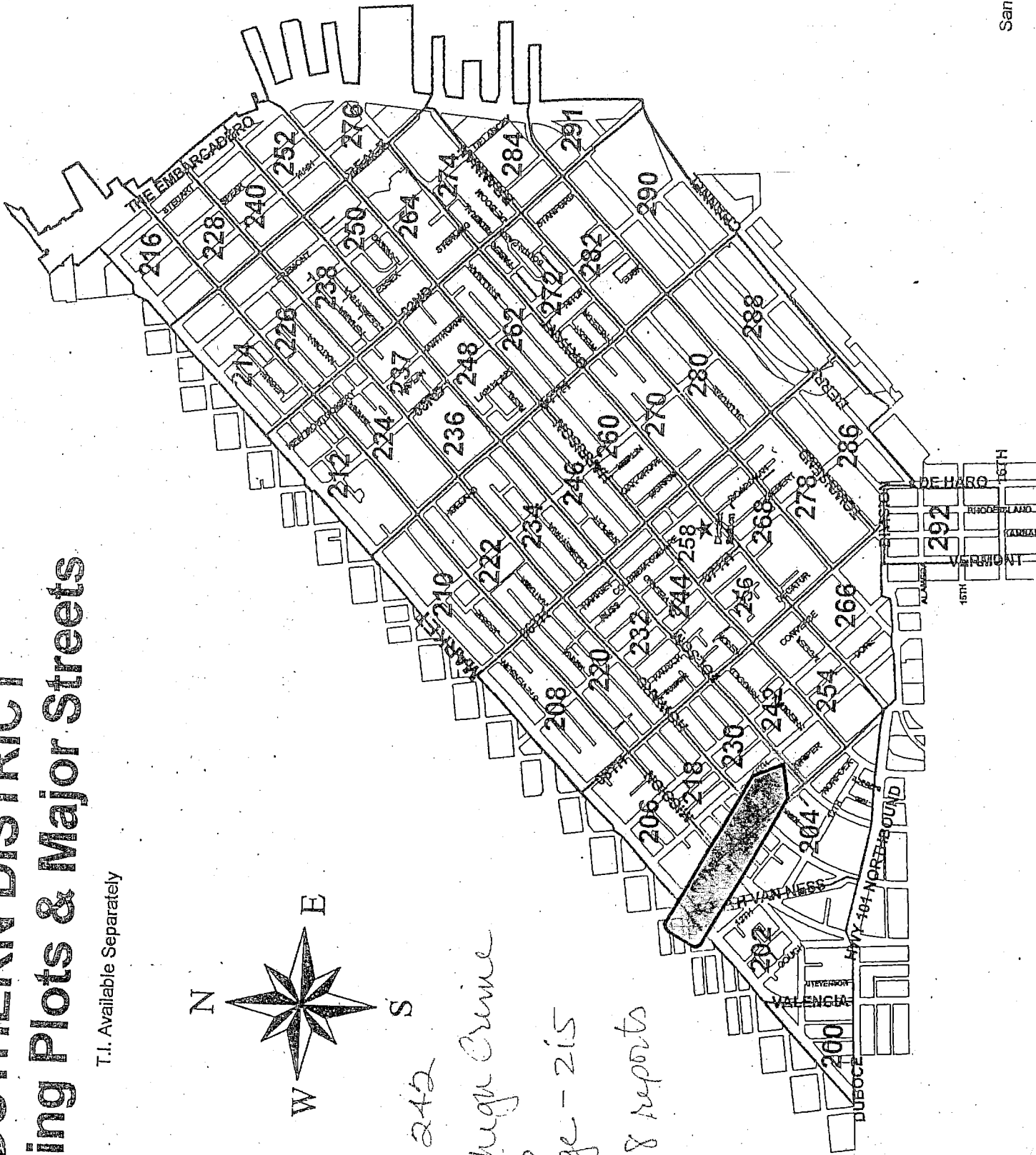

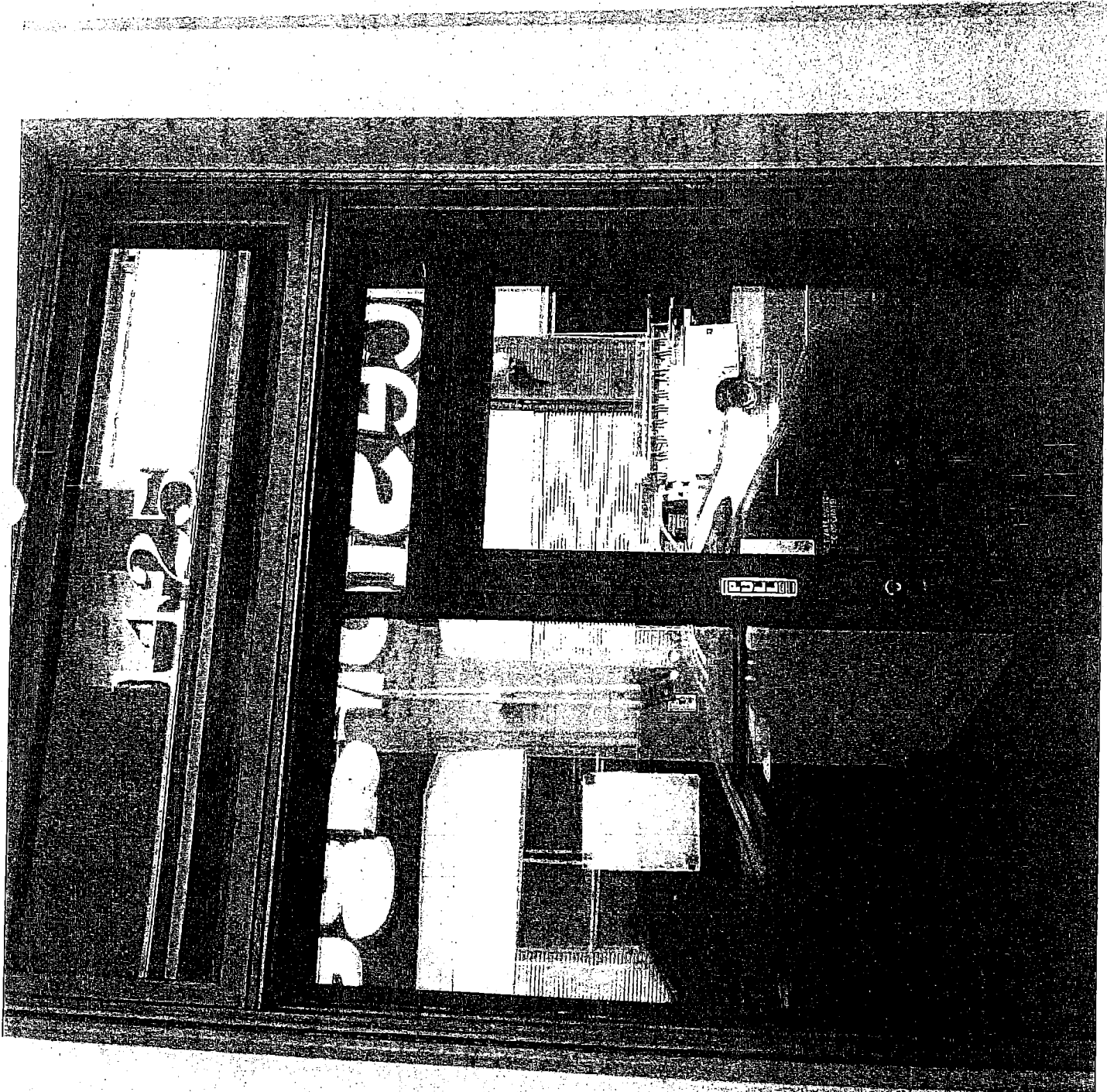

Folsom Street Foundry will expand on the concept of a bar/gallery with strategic use of high quality LED monitors. This allows us to offer dozens, and eventually hundreds of pieces of

digital concept art for viewing. Each of these potentially hundreds of artworks will be available for sale as limited edition prints through our retail store with custom orders available through our printer affiliate.

The Folsom Street Foundry will strive to become a central hub for the growth and development of creative energy in San Francisco. The idea of taking a concept or 'dream' and making it into a reality is the focus of the venue. We have already begun reaching out to our neighbors and plan on helping the SOMA area continue to develop into a place associated with great art and technological creativity.


While digital concept art is an area of significant employment among art school graduates and graphic designers, there is currently no venue for them to showcase their work aside from a few websites.
