[Adding the Name "Enid Ng Lim Alley" to Bartol Street]

Resolution adding the name "Enid Ng Lim Alley" to Bartol Street in recognition of Enid Ng Lim and her many contributions to San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Enid Ng Lim championed equality, justice and opportunity throughout her life; and

WHEREAS, Enid, a native San Franciscan, utilized her education, life experiences, great spirit, and determination to connect Chinatown's interests with those of greater San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, Enid was appointed by Mayor Willie L. Brown, Jr. as one of the original members of the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors in 2000 and served as the inaugural Vice President of the Board from 2000 - 2003, where she utilized her perspective as a regular Muni rider to provide leadership on improving paratransit, accessibility, service quality and training for Muni operators and staff; and

WHEREAS, Enid was a member of San Francisco Tomorrow, and was instrumental in expanding transit in under-served areas of the City through tireless advocacy of route design and scheduling; and

WHEREAS. Enid served for many years with Chinatown TRIP, an organization which brought attention to Chinatown's mobility and transit concerns, and she is regarded as the "Mother" of the Central Subway that will link the Third Street Light Rail with Chinatown, a vital project that her early vision and advocacy enabled to be environmentally approved and fast-tracked for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, Enid worked for many years in the Chinatown community with the Chinatown Resource Center on historical issues and preservation of historic sites, the

Presbyterian Church's Cameron House on their youth programs, and San Francisco City Hall as a Docent; and

WHEREAS, Enid served on the staff of the Chinatown Community Development
Center and was a member of the Chinatown Alleyway Improvement Association, which both
continually advocated for Bartol Alley improvements; and

WHEREAS, Enid's work aided in keeping 1000 Montgomery, a single room occupancy hotel that had opened in 1989, a place for affordable senior housing, which On Lok Community Housing now manages; and

WHEREAS, Enid spent her last days at On Lok at Bartol Alley; therefore, be it RESOLVED, That, consistent with San Francisco Public Works Code Section 701, the honorary naming of "Enid Ng Lim Alley," be in recognition of her valued contributions to the City of San Francisco and the community of Chinatown; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests the Municipal Transport Agency to erect street signs indicating both the new and the former names of the street, with the new name "Enid Ng Lim Alley" in large letters, and the old name "Bartol Street" in smaller letters above or beneath the new name; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That both of the street names, "Enid Ng Lim Alley" and "Bartol Street," shall remain posted permanently.
