FURTHER RESOLVED, That the applicant agrees to provide all in-kind or cash match contributions required for said project (including any amendment thereof) under the program and funding items and conditions of OCJP; and, be it

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AGREED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award

Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant
recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility
for any such liability; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
