

1 (GRANTS FEDERAL FUNDS)  
2 AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO ACCEPT AND  
3 EXPEND \$28,171,395 OF FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (STP),  
4 AND SECTION 5307 CAPITAL ASSISTANCE FOR FOUR MUNICIPAL RAILWAY  
5 CAPITAL PROJECTS AND ONE DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC CAPITAL  
6 PROJECT, INCLUDING \$369,702 FOR ADMINISTRATIVE OVERHEAD COSTS.

7 WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available  
8 pursuant to the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21) for mass transportation  
9 projects; and

10 WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission, City and County of San Francisco, is  
11 an eligible claimant for flexible capital assistance projects pursuant to the Surface Transportation  
12 Program (STD) included in the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century; and

13 WHEREAS, The Public Transportation Commission, City and County of San Francisco, is  
14 an eligible claimant for capital assistance projects pursuant to Section 5307 of the Transportation  
15 Equity Act for the 21st Century; and

16 WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon  
17 the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of project costs; and

18 WHEREAS, The local share of project costs can be funded through a variety of sources  
19 including Pacific Gas and Electric funds, Regional Bridge Toll Net Revenues, San Francisco  
20 Municipal Railway Improvement Corporation, and/or San Francisco County Transportation Sales  
21 Taxes; and

22 WHEREAS, the required matching funds were authorized separately; and

23 WHEREAS, It is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the  
24 provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an  
25 application for federal assistance, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI  
of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. Department of Transportation requirements  
thereunder; and

1           **WHEREAS**, It is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprises be  
2 utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive procedures  
3 shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses shall have the  
4 maximum possible opportunity to compete for contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or  
5 consultant and other services; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Federal Section 5307 is a formula-apportioned resource that may be used for  
7 any eligible capital purpose; and

8           **WHEREAS**, STP is a formula-apportioned resource that may be used for any eligible  
9 planning or capital purpose; and

10           **WHEREAS**, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) has prepared a regional  
11 program of projects for Section 5307 and STP capital assistance funding; and

12           **WHEREAS**, The Municipal Railway's projects that are included in the regional program  
13 are high priority Municipal Railway capital improvements called for in the current Short Range  
14 Transit Plan and in the Regional Transportation Plan; and

15           **WHEREAS**, The program of project costs are estimated as follows:

- Construction/Purchase/Consultant Contracts	\$27,465,600
- In-House Design/Project Management/Rehabilitation	\$336,093
- Indirect Costs	\$369,702
<b>Total Project Cost</b>	<b>\$28,171,395</b>

19           **RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to execute and file  
20 an application on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco with the United States Department  
21 of Transportation to aid in the capital assistance projects pursuant to Section 5307, and STP  
22 program funding; and be it

23           **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to  
24 execute and file with such application an assurance or any other document required by the United  
25 States Department of Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of  
1964; and be it

1           **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to  
2 execute fund transfer agreements with the State of California and the Metropolitan Transportation  
3 Commission, to accept these funds; and be it


4           **RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to accept and  
5 expend \$28,171,395 in federal STP and Section 5307 capital assistance for the following capital  
6 projects:


- 7           • Duboce Avenue/Bicycle Facility
- 8           • Islais Creek Maintenance Facility
- 9           • Light Rail Vehicle Purchase
- 10          • Transit Preferential Streets Signal Equipment
- 11          • Trolley Coach Purchase; and be it

12           **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to  
13 furnish whatever additional information might be requested by the funding agencies in connection  
14 with this request; and be it

15           **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Public Transportation Commission is authorized to set  
16 forth and execute affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection with the project's  
17 procurement needs;




