5 RESOLVED, That, pursuant to the provisions of the California Vehicle Code, the
6 following intersections are hereby designated as "STOP" intersections, and the
7 Department of Parking and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to cause "STOP"
8 signs to be installed thereat as designated below:

9 **STOP SIGNS - ESTABLISH**

- 10 38th Avenue and Irving Street, stopping Irving Street at 38th Avenue, making this
- 11 an all-way STOP;
- 12 22nd Avenue and Ortega Street, stopping Ortega Street at 22nd Avenue, making
- 13 this an all-way STOP; and
- 14 21st Avenue and Irving Street, stopping Irving Street at 21st Avenue, making this
- 15 an all-way STOP.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.


