Who We Are








Average Caseloads for Attorneys




Causes:

Trial Delays

Increase in DA filings

Decrease in DA referrals to diversion programs and specialty courts
Increased workloads due to changes in state law (e.g., Racial Justice Act and Mental Health Diversion) and body worn camera, video surveillance footage, and cell phone technology
