17 Caulkers and Cleaners, Local 3 and Hodcarriers, Local 36 by appending a Letter of
18 Agreement concerning the City's 2002-2003 budget which provides: (a) for the City to reduce
19 its "pick-up" of the required employee contribution to the retirement system by 2.75% of the
20 employees' compensation effective July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003; (b) a 1% base wage


