AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND UP TO \$514,897.00 IN OIL RECYCLING GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD; WAIVING INDIRECT COSTS.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and maintaining local used oil collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate disposal of used oil; and,

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) was delegated the responsibility to administer the program within the state and set up procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and,

WHEREAS, the City has entered into an agreement with the State of California for development of the oil recycling project; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of San Francisco citizens to establish and implement waste diversion and separation programs to prevent the disposal of hazardous waste, including used motor oil, in solid waste landfills or in the sewage system; and,

WHEREAS, the City has increased the options to recycle and/or appropriately dispose of used oil in San Francisco and the City intends to further expand this program to provide more service to the citizens of San Francisco; and,


WHEREAS, the CIWMB does not allow for the inclusion of indirect cost; now, therefore be it


RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Administrator to accept and expend Used Oil Recycling Grant funding from the CIWMB for up to \$514,897.00; and, be it


