URGING THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO EXERCISE ITS OPTION TO PURCHASE 59 LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES AS PROMPTLY AS POSSIBLE AND URGING THE MAYOR AND SAN FRANCISCO'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO SECURE

FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION APPROVAL FOR THE ACQUISITION AS AN IMMEDIATE PRIORITY.

WHEREAS, Recent experience with MUNI Metro has clearly demonstrated that replacing the system's old Boeing LRVs is the principal priority to improve the level of service during peak periods; and

WHEREAS, MUNI officials had the foresight to include an option for 59 additional LRVs in its last vehicle order; and

WHEREAS, The exercise of this purchase option would allow San Francisco to significantly speed the manufacture and delivery of its LRVs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby urges the Public Transportation

Commission to expedite the exercise of its option to purchase 59 additional LRVs immediately
and urges the Mayor and San Francisco's Congressional delegation to secure Federal Transit

Administration approval for this acquisition as an immediate priority.
