Background


Capital Plan Adopted April 2013

- Proposed: \$150m Transportation General Obligation (G.O.) Bond for the Nov 2014 ballot
- BOS request: CPC amend the Capital Plan, following the release of the Transportation Taskforce's final recommendations, to increase the Transportation G.O. Bond
 - Assuming Task Force recommends an increase
 - Increase does not result in the 2006 G.O. Bond tax rate cap being exceeded

Task Force Recommendations Released Nov 2013

- Identified: \$6 billion in unfunded transportation capital needs over the next 15 years
- Recommended: \$500m Transportation G.O. Bond to help address critical urgent capital needs for Nov 2014

- Increase in Transportation Bond amount possible due to:
 - Increased Assessed Value (AV)
 - Phasing of the Transportation Bond issuances
