1 [Golden Gate Park - West End Pavilion]

2 APPROVING CONSTRUCTION OF THE WEST END PAVILION IN GOLDEN GATE PARK
3 BY THE FRIENDS OF RECREATION AND PARKS AND ITS ACCEPTANCE AS A GIFT
4 IN PLACE; FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE GENERAL
5 PLAN AND THE EIGHT PRIORITY POLICIES OF PLANNING CODE SECTION 101.1;
6 AND ADOPTING CEQA FINDINGS AS PRESENTED BY THE RECREATION AND PARK
7 COMMISSION.

9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter Section 4.113(1), new construction
10 in Golden Gate Park requires two-thirds approval of the Board of
11 Supervisors; and

12 WHEREAS, The Golden Gate Park Master Plan, adopted by the
13 Recreation and Park Commission in October 1998, recommended the
14 construction of a West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park; and

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11/9 15 WHEREAS, The Master Plan Environmental Impact Report ~~and~~
16 identified the construction of the pavilion as part of a preservation
17 alternative and construction of the pavilion will not adversely
18 affect any historic resources; and

19 WHEREAS, The Golden Gate Park Master Plan Environmental Impact
20 Report was certified by the Planning Commission in Planning
21 Commission Resolution No. 14653 as adequate, complete, reflecting the
22 independent judgment of the Planning Commission and in compliance
23 with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"); and

1 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission adopted findings
2 pursuant to CEQA in Recreation and Park Commission Resolution No.
3 9810-141; and

4 WHEREAS, Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15168(e), this
5 project has been found to be within the scope of the Golden Gate Park
6 Master Plan, and the program Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for
7 the Golden Gate Park Draft Master Plan adequately describes the
8 activity for the purposes of CEQA; and

9 WHEREAS, Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162, the Board of
10 Supervisors finds that the project has not changed, that there are no
11 changed circumstances under which the project is undertaken, and that
12 there is no new information available that would result in new or
13 substantially more severe environmental effects or new mitigation
14 measures or feasible alternatives not identified and discussed in the
15 Environmental Impact Report; and

16 WHEREAS, Mitigation measures adopted in the mitigation
17 monitoring plan relevant to this project will be carried out as part
18 of this project. These mitigations include avoiding or minimizing
19 southwestern pond turtles mortalities during construction, and
20 following specified procedures if archaeological remains are
21 discovered; and

22 WHEREAS, The Planning Commission found that the Golden Gate Park
23 Master Plan and the construction of the West End Pavilion are
24 consistent with the General Plan for the City and County of San
25 Francisco and the Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section

1 101.1 in Planning Commission Resolution No. 14654 and the letter from
2 the Planning Department dated November 2, 1999; and

3 WHEREAS, The Friends of Recreation and Parks is constructing the
4 pavilion as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000; and

5 WHEREAS, The new pavilion will be managed by the Recreation and
6 Park Department to be available for public use; and

7
8 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission approved the
9 conceptual plan for the West End Pavilion and accepted the
10 construction of the pavilion from the Friends of Recreation and Parks
11 as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000; now, therefore,
12 be it

13 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors adopts the CEQA findings
14 set forth in Recreation and Park Commission Resolution No. 9810-141
15 and incorporates such findings by this reference thereto; and be it

16
17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby finds
18 that the construction of the West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park is
19 consistent with the General Plan and the Eight Priority Policies set
20 forth in Planning Code Section 101.1 for the reasons set forth in
21 Planning Commission Resolution No. 14654 and the Planning Department
22 letter dated November 2, 1999; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Recreation and Park Department shall
24 implement the mitigation measures adopted in the Mitigation

1 Monitoring Program that are relevant to this construction project;
2 and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the
4 construction of the West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park pursuant to
5 Charter Section 4.113(1); and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts the
7 construction of the pavilion from the Friends of Recreation and Parks
8 as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000.

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
