BY THE FRIENDS OF RECREATION AND PARKS AND ITS ACCEPTANCE AS A GIFT IN PLACE; FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE GENERAL PLAN AND THE EIGHT PRIORITY POLICIES OF PLANNING CODE SECTION 101.1; AND ADOPTING CEQA FINDINGS AS PRESENTED BY THE RECREATION AND PARK COMMISSION.

APPROVING CONSTRUCTION OF THE WEST END PAVILION IN GOLDEN GATE PARK

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter Section 4.113(1), new construction in Golden Gate Park requires two-thirds approval of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The Golden Gate Park Master Plan, adopted by the Recreation and Park Commission in October 1998, recommended the construction of a West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park; and

WHEREAS, The Master Plan Environmental Impact Report and identified the construction of the pavilion as part of a preservation alternative and construction of the pavilion will not adversely affect any historic resources; and

WHEREAS, The Golden Gate Park Master Plan Environmental Impact
Report was certified by the Planning Commission in Planning
Commission Resolution No. 14653 as adequate, complete, reflecting the
independent judgment of the Planning Commission and in compliance
with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"); and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission adopted findings pursuant to CEQA in Recreation and Park Commission Resolution No. 9810-141; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15168(e), this project has been found to be within the scope of the Golden Gate Park Master Plan, and the program Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Golden Gate Park Draft Master Plan adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162, the Board of Supervisors finds that the project has not changed, that there are no changed circumstances under which the project is undertaken, and that there is no new information available that would result in new or substantially more severe environmental effects or new mitigation measures or feasible alternatives not identified and discussed in the Environmental Impact Report; and

WHEREAS, Mitigation measures adopted in the mitigation monitoring plan relevant to this project will be carried out as part of this project. These mitigations include avoiding or minimizing southwestern pond turtles mortalities during construction, and following specified procedures if archaeological remains are discovered; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission found that the Golden Gate Park
Master Plan and the construction of the West End Pavilion are
consistent with the General Plan for the City and County of San
Francisco and the Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code Section

101.1 in Planning Commission Resolution No. 14654 and the letter from the Planning Department dated November 2, 1999; and

WHEREAS, The Friends of Recreation and Parks is constructing the pavilion as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, The new pavilion will be managed by the Recreation and Park Department to be available for public use; and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission approved the conceptual plan for the West End Pavilion and accepted the construction of the pavilion from the Friends of Recreation and Parks as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors adopts the CEQA findings set forth in Recreation and Park Commission Resolution No. 9810-141 and incorporates such findings by this reference thereto; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby finds that the construction of the West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park is consistent with the General Plan and the Eight Priority Policies set forth in Planning Code Section 101.1 for the reasons set forth in Planning Commission Resolution No. 14654 and the Planning Department letter dated November 2, 1999; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Recreation and Park Department shall implement the mitigation measures adopted in the Mitigation

Monitoring Program that are relevant to this construction project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the construction of the West End Pavilion in Golden Gate Park pursuant to Charter Section 4.113(1); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts the construction of the pavilion from the Friends of Recreation and Parks as a gift in place valued at approximately \$500,000.
