

1 [Amending Ordinance Creating an Underground District on Funston Avenue in the Richmond  
2 District.]

3 **Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 171-80 to redefine Underground District 312,**  
4 **Funston Avenue District, by requiring that all aerial utility facilities in this District,**  
5 **including those located on private property in rear easements, be placed underground,**  
6 **and by requiring property owners to provide and maintain the underground support**  
7 **structures on their properties.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of Article 18, Section 901 et seq. to 913  
14 ~~inclusive, of Ordinance No. 139-72, codified as Article 18, Chapter X, Part II~~ of the San Francisco  
15 ~~Municipal Public Works~~ Code, the Board of Supervisors do hereby create the following  
16 underground district:

17 UNDERGROUND DISTRICT NO. 312

18 Funston Avenue, from the northerly line of Fulton  
19 Street to 72 Feet northerly from Lake Street

20 Section 2. The undergrounding of facilities within this underground district is in the  
21 general public interest by eliminating a heavy concentration of overhead wires in a scenic  
22 area and was requested by petition and association request.

23 Section 3. All work in connection with the undergrounding of facilities lying within this  
24 underground district and subject to the laws with reference to underground districts is to be  
25 completed in accordance with the Department of Public Works program; provided, however,

1 that said work shall be commenced at such time or according to such priority as the Department of  
2 Public Works establishes.

3 Section 4. In this underground district, all aerial utility facilities, including aerial facilities on  
4 private property or in rear easements, shall be placed underground. All property owners in this area  
5 shall provide and maintain the underground supporting structure on their properties.
