11	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
12	Section 20.205.2, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 20.205.2. APPLICATION FOR SSI.
14	(a) All applicants for SSIP must apply to the SSA for SSI, but have not yet
15	received SSI benefits.
16	(b) The Department of Human Services shall establish an SSI advocacy program to
17	assist recipients in applying and completing the requirements for SSI, including pursuit of all
18	reconsideration and appeals processes. DHS shall provide these services directly and through
19	contracts with community-based agencies offering SSI advocacy services.
20	$(b\underline{c})$ If an applicant has been discontinued from, or determined to be ineligible
21	for, SSI by the SSA, based upon requirements other than failure to establish a disability within
22	the meaning of SSA regulations, that applicant shall not be eligible for SSIP or However, such
23	applicant may be eligible for assistance under the PAES, CALM or General Assistance Programs.
24	(<u>d</u> -e) SSIP applicants and/or recipients shall:
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1	(1) Apply for SSI/SSP if a disabling condition is likely to exist or has existed
2	for twelve (12) consecutive months a year or longer, authorize Department of Human Services
3	reimbursement of SSIP payments from retroactive SSI/SSP benefits, also known as Interim
4	Assistance Reimbursement, and pursue and comply with the procedures under the SSI/SSP
5	Program for successful qualification for benefits under that program; and
6	(2) Participate in an SSI advocacy program either through DHS or through a DHS
7	approved community-based agency offering SSI advocacy services.
8	(23) Apply for and pursue a claim for any other appropriate benefit program
9	available to the applicant or recipient and pursue and comply with the procedures for

12	Section 20.205.2A, to read as follows:
13	SEC. 20.205.2A. Funding for SSI Advocacy Services. SSI Advocacy services provided by DHS
14	directly and through contracts with community-based agencies offering SSI advocacy services shall be
15	subject to availability of funding.
