

1 [Contract funds for a safety trial of Tenofovir as a pre-exposure prophylaxis among high-risk  
2 men who have sex with men.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
5 **enter retroactively into an agreement with Public Health Foundation Enterprises, Inc.**  
6 **(PHFE), the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$100,929 for a**  
7 **safety trial of Tenofovir as a pre-exposure prophylaxis among high-risk men who have**  
8 **sex with men; for the period of October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2004.**

10 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the Centers for Disease  
11 Control and Prevention to participate in a safety trial of Tenofovir as a pre-exposure  
12 prophylaxis among high-risk men who have sex with men; and,

13 WHEREAS, PHFE, and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to  
14 participate in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$100,929 from  
16 this award under the terms of this subcontract agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, PHFE requires SFDPH to enter into  
18 an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
19 Supervisors in File No. 031844, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
20 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$13,921;  
22 and,

23 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
24 because we did not receive the subcontract until September 24, 2003; and,


1 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
2 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
3 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
4 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract  
6 agreement in the amount of \$100,929 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it


7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
10 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when

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
