4	provides members of the Assessment Appeals Boards for each hearing.

10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	
12	Section 1. Chapter 2B of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising
13	Section 2B.5, to read as follows:
14	SEC. 2B.5. COMPENSATION OF BOARD MEMBERS.
15	(a) Except when serving as an assessment hearing officer under Section 2B.14, the
16	compensation of regular and alternate members of the Assessment Appeals Boards shall be
17	as follows:
18	(1) \$175 for each morning, afternoon, or evening, or portion thereof, of a hearing on
19	which the member serves, not to exceed \$525 for each calendar day. 125 for each hearing on which the
20	member serves if the hearing is confined to a morning or afternoon;
21	(2) If a member serves on a hearing that starts in the morning and continues into the
22	afternoon, or continues from one day to another regardless of whether it started in the morning or
23	afternoon, the member shall receive \$125 for each morning and \$125 for each afternoon of the
24	member's serving on that hearing; and
25	

1	— (3) In no event shall compensation for a member exceed \$375 for each calendar day on
2	which the member serves.
3	(42) For purposes of this subsection (a), "hearing" means the Board or a panel of
4	the Board convening to consider the matter or matters that appear on a single meeting
5	agenda; and "serves" means to attend a hearing in one's capacity as a member of the Board.
6	(b) When serving as an assessment hearing officer under Section 2B.14, the
7	compensation of regular and alternate members of the Assessment Appeals Boards shall be
8	as follows:
9	(1) \$175125 for each morning, or afternoon, or evening, or portion thereof, of a
10	hearing on which the member serves service, not to exceed \$350250 for each calendar day on
11	which the member serves.
12	(2) For purposes of this subsection (b), "serves" means to attend a hearing in
13	one's capacity as an assessment hearing officer.
14	(c) For purposes of this Section 2B.5, "morning" means 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., "afternoon"
15	means 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m., and "evening" means 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
16	
17	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
18	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
19	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within 10 days of receiving it, or the Board
20	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
21	
22	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
23	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
24	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal

Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Compensation for Assessment Appeals Board Members]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase the compensation the City provides members of the Assessment Appeals Boards for each hearing.

Existing Law

The Assessment Appeals Board ("AAB") decides disputes between the Assessor's Office and property owners concerning the valuation of taxable property within the City for the purposes of taxation. The AAB consists of three boards, each with five members and three alternate members. The City provides members of the AAB \$125 for each morning, afternoon, and evening session, with a maximum payment of \$375 per day when a member serves on a panel and \$250 per day when a member serves as a hearing officer.

Amendments to Current Law


The proposed ordinance would increase the compensation the City provides members of the AAB to \$175 for each morning, afternoon, and evening session, with a maximum payment of \$525 each day a member serves on a panel and \$350 per day when a member serves as a hearing officer.

#17 Ordinance to Increase Assessment Appeals Board Member Stipends.

- Increases Assessment Appeals Board Member Stipends from \$125 to \$175 per session
- Last updated in 2019, member stipends require an increase to reflect the higher volume of appeals and higher number of hearings attended by Members.
- San Francisco's Members are paid lower than their counterparts in other counties.
 - Five counties in California of comparable size and importance, compensate their Board Members \$300 for an 8-hour per day or \$37.50 per hour while San Francisco AAB members receive an estimate of \$31.25 per hour.
 - Compared to twelve similar counties, the stipend received by San Francisco AAB Members ranks 7th overall or in the middle.
