WHEREAS, AIDS and HIV pose a threat to national public health and there are more than 9,000 people presently living with AIDS in San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco is ranked third in the cumulative number of AIDS cases among metropolitan areas nationwide; and.

WHEREAS, Latinos comprise 14% of San Francisco's total population and make up 14.6% of new AIDS cases; and,

WHEREAS, Among people 13-24 years old, Latino youth in San Francisco make up the highest percentage of AIDS cases diagnosed since the beginning of the AIDS/HIV epidemic: and.

WHEREAS, The national rates of Latina women exposed to AIDS has climbed from 15% to 23% over the last twelve years; and,

WHEREAS, AIDS and HIV infection has dramatically impacted Latino communities throughout the United States due to late diagnoses and low rate of insurance coverage; and,

WHEREAS, October 15 is the last day of Hispanic Heritage Month and the date chosen by health care programs in San Antonio, Atlanta, New York, and Los Angeles to educate the public on AIDS prevention; now, therefore, be it

urge health care providers and government agencies to educate their public on epidemics
