

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant]

2 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor’s Office of Criminal Justice (MOCJ) to accept and**
3 **expend a grant in the amount of \$139,366 from the California Governor’s Office of**
4 **Emergency Services (OES) Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Program (ADA) for the**
5 **purpose of reducing drug related crime through a coordinated approach.**

6 WHEREAS, MOCJ is the lead fiscal agency in administering the ADA Program; and

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco applied and was awarded on September 23, 2007, one
8 hundred and thirty-nine thousand and three hundred and sixty-six dollars (\$139,366); and

9 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department, San Francisco District Attorney’s
10 Office, San Francisco Adult Probation Department and the San Francisco Sheriff’s
11 Department will be responsible for coordination and day-to-day operations of the planning and
12 implementation phases of this grant; and

13 WHEREAS, MOCJ will be responsible for the fiscal, programmatic and administrative
14 reporting to OES; now, therefore, be it

15 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

16 WHEREAS, MOCJ proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program
17 expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in
19 the grant budget; now therefore be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes
21 MOCJ to accept and expend \$139,366 from OES, to administer the ADA Program.
