3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend a grant**  
4 **in the amount of \$127,241 from the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the**  
5 **operation of the Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution Program.**

7 WHEREAS, The District Attorney's Office and the City and County of San Francisco  
8 desire to continue a certain project designated the Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution  
9 Program with funds made available through the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning  
10 (OCJP); and,

11 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded "G" in the District  
12 Attorney's budget; and,

13 WHEREAS, The District Attorney proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
14 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

15 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in  
16 the grant budget; and be it

17 **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the District Attorney of the City and County of San  
18 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and  
19 expend funds from OCJP to continue the Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution Program; and  
20 be it

21 **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That in the event the OCJP consents to continue funding the  
22 Major Narcotic Vendors Prosecution Program, the District Attorney of the City and County of  
23 San Francisco is authorized to execute any amendments or augmentations of said program  
24 except as any amendment or augmentation would increase any hard matching fund  
25 obligations of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to the contract; and be it



6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant  
7 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the  
8 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
10 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.


