The Department is requesting retroactive approval for the ordinance to allow for currently planned retail theft blitz operations during the holiday shopping period to be charged to the grant once the ordinance is fully adopted. The grant performance period starts October 1, 2023 and the earliest adoption date of the ordinance will be early January. This will allow eligible overtime costs from the blitz operations to be retroactively billed as grant activities. If retroactive approval is not granted, then the grant activities during this period will not be able to be billed, and only prospective activities after passage of the ordinance can be billed.
