RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Parking and Traffic to seek, wherever possible, funding for the expansion of the Page Street Mini-Circle project from Scott Street to Fillmore Street; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors request the clerk of the Board to forward a copy of this resolution to the Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic.
