[Assembly Bill 1463- California Driver's License Requirements]

URGING THE CALIFORNIA STATE LEGISLATURE AND GOVERNOR DAVIS TO APPROVE

STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 1463 MODIFYING EXISTING SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER

AND LAWFUL PRESENCE REQUIREMENTS TO ENABLE MORE INDIVIDUALS TO APPLY

FOR A CALIFORNIA DRIVER'S LICENSE.

WHEREAS, Under current law, Californians must provide the Department of Motor Vehicles with a Social Security Number and Proof of Lawful Presence in the United States in order to receive a driver's license; and,

WHEREAS, Current law restricts the ability of immigrants who are in the process of applying for lawful status to obtain a California driver's license; and

WHEREAS, As a result of current law, many people who cannot meet the requirements for a driver's license choose to drive without one in order to support themselves and their families but do so without proper instruction or driving techniques, creating unsafe driving conditions; and

WHEREAS, Owning and operating an automobile is key to participating in our economic prosperity; and

WHEREAS, Drivers who cannot lawfully obtain a driver's license cannot obtain auto insurance so many immigrants drive without insurance; and

WHEREAS, Uninsured drivers create a cost burden for the state and for all drivers; and

WHEREAS, The public is better served by a policy that encourages all drivers to be licensed and insured; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1463, authored by Assemblymember Gilbert Cedillo, will allow immigrants who are in the process of obtaining lawful immigration status or who have filed a petition or application with the INS to gain lawful status to receive a California driver's license; and

WHEREAS, AB 1463 is supported by numerous groups around the State and the country including the American Civil Liberties Union, the California Union of Safety Employees, the Association of Asian Pacific Community Health Organizations and the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges the Legislature and Governor to approve Assembly Bill 1463 modifying existing Social Security Number and Lawful Presence requirements to enable more individuals to apply for a California driver's license; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from San Francisco in the State legislature, as well as Governor Davis, asking that they take all action necessary to pass Assembly Bill 1463.
