Targeted HIV/TB Strategic Information Technical Assistance for President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM) Countries

- Grant Summary: To provide technical expertise on international HIV/AIDS surveillance and epidemiology
- Funder: Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- Amount: \$107,707
- Timeline: September 30, 2023 September 29, 2024

Overview of Grant (continued)



History, purpose, activities, benefits

- PEPFAR and Global Fund enlist SFDPH's unique expertise in addressing the HIV epidemic among sexual and gender minority people (esp. MSM and trans women)
- SFDPH has received funding from PEPFAR since its inception in 2003 (via UCSF)
- We provide training and technical assistance to national programs in Africa, Asia, Latin America, Central Asia, and Eastern Europe on collecting and using data to advocate for HIV prevention and care programs for populations at high risk
- The program strengthens SFDPH's HIV epidemic response through exchange visits from officials of national ministries of health

Conclusion



SFDPH is seeking retroactive authorization to accept this grant.

- SFDPH was notified of the grant increase on January 24, 2024.
- The project period for this grant began September
 20, 2023 and continues through September 29, 2024.
- The grant increase of \$18,016 augmented the total award to \$107,707, above \$100,000 threshold for Board Approval.
