WHEREAS, California's first State Fair was held in San Francisco in 1854; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Fair has been held every year since 1854 for a total of 147 years; and,

WHEREAS, The location of the first California State Fair is a California State Landmark, which is commemorated by a plaque at 269 Bush Street; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Fair is California's largest cultural celebration; and, WHEREAS, Approximately 1 million people visit the California State Fair each year; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Fair and related activities generate the equivalent of 2,000 jobs and a combined economic benefit of \$350 million annually; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County San Francisco sent an exhibit to the 1999 California State Fair and was awarded with a Silver Award in recognition of its unique and marketable exhibit; and,

WHEREAS, The California State Fair county exhibits are marketing opportunities for counties to present the unique and attractive qualities of the county and promote the county as a tourist destination; and,

WHEREAS, All county exhibits must be entered with the official approval of the county Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Department of Consumer Assurance, Regulatory Compliance and Agricultural Standards is the body traditionally charged with responsibility for California State Fair exhibits; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco urges the City and County of San Francisco's Department of Consumer Assurance, Regulatory Compliance and Agricultural Standards to participate in the counties exhibits and the California State Fair on an ongoing annual basis.
