

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - Department of Justice - Comprehensive Opioid,  
2 Stimulant, and Substance Use Site-Based Program - \$1,600,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$1,600,000 from the Department of Justice for**  
5 **participation in a program entitled, “Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance**  
6 **Use Site-Based Program,” for the period of October 1, 2024, through September 30,**  
7 **2027.**

9 WHEREAS, The Department of Justice (DOJ) has agreed to fund the San Francisco  
10 Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$1,600,000 for the period of October 1,  
11 2024, through September 30, 2027; and

12 WHEREAS, DPH, through its Office of Overdose Prevention, will implement the  
13 program entitled Data-driven Health Systems Change for Prevention (DHSCP); and

14 WHEREAS, The purpose of this program is to develop a comprehensive, collaborative,  
15 and innovative Overdose Fatality Review (OFR), incorporating key partners from across San  
16 Francisco; and

17 WHEREAS, Expected outcomes include establishing a comprehensive and  
18 collaborative OFR; timely, actionable, community-responsive, and locally-specific overdose  
19 fatality data; enhanced collaboration across healthcare, public safety, justice-involved, and  
20 community partners; enhanced understanding of service gaps and identification of potential  
21 touchpoints for overdose interventions; and the identification of local, context-specific  
22 solutions to prevent overdose; and

23 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

24 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received  
25 the award letter on November 15, 2024, for a project start date of October 1, 2024; and

1           WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of  
2 \$16,178; now, therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant  
4 in the amount of \$1,600,000 from the DOJ; and, be it

5           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1; and, be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
8 Agreement on behalf of the City.
