8	WHEREAS, In response to the California Energy crisis, on January 22, 2001 the Mayor		
9	of the City and County of San Francisco (the City) directed department heads to take all		
10	measures necessary to accomplish energy use reductions; and		
11	WHEREAS, The Mayor designated the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission		
12	(SFPUC) as the lead agency to assist City departments to effectively manage their energy		
13	use; and,		
14	WHEREAS, In order to maximize the number of renewable energy projects that could		
15	be accomplished with the limited funds available, the SFPUC staff identified potential grant		
16	funding sources through the PG&E Self-Generation Incentive Program; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved a Design-Build contract for a		
18	renewable energy solar system at the George R. Moscone Convention Center (Moscone		
19	Center) in its resolution number 621-02; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The SFPUC approved funding for the Moscone Center solar system in its		
21	resolution No. 02-0105; and,		
22	WHEREAS, PG&E has approved a grant amount of approximately \$2,127,054		
23	depending on actual project costs, for a solar system at the Moscone Center, which will		
24	reimburse Hetch Hetchy Enterprise funds used for the project; and

1	WHEREAS, The SFPUC proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on		
2	program expenditures by excluding indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it		
3	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs		
4	the grant budget; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes this resolution to		
6	accept and expend a grant in the amount of approximately \$2,127,054 from PG&E to suppo		
7	a renewable energy solar project at the Moscone Convention Center.
