URGING GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND THE MEDIA TO EXERCISE CAUTION AND FAIRNESS IN THE INVESTIGATION AND REPORTING OF ALLEGATIONS AGAINST FORMER LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL LABORATORY SCIENTIST DR. WEN HO LEE.

WHEREAS, On Friday, December 10, 1999, nuclear physicist Dr. Wen Ho Lee was arrested and charged with 59 counts of mishandling classified information and violating secrecy provisions of the Atomic Energy Act; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Wen Ho Lee is currently being held without bail in a New Mexico detention facility; and,

WHEREAS, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) officials in March 1999, after three years of investigation of Dr. Wen Ho Lee for possible espionage, have acknowledged that they still lack concrete evidence that Dr. Wen Ho Lee has committed any espionage; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Wen Ho Lee was abruptly and summarily dismissed from his position at Los Alamos National Laboratory by the Department of Energy (DOE) on March 8, 1999, two days after the *New York Times* reported that Taiwan-born American scientist Dr. Wen Ho Lee was under investigation by the FBI for possible espionage; and,

WHEREAS, All Americans -- whether by birth or by naturalization -- are entitled to due process of law, as guaranteed by the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, The premise under the United States Constitution is the presumption of innocence unless proof beyond the shadow of a reasonable doubt is established; now, therefore be it,
