

1 [Agreement - San Francisco Community Health Authority - Healthy San Francisco Private
2 Provider Network - Not to Exceed \$41,648,505]

3 **Resolution approving the agreement between the City and County of San Francisco,**
4 **acting by and through, the Department of Public Health (DPH), and San Francisco**
5 **Community Health Authority, to pay private network providers for the Healthy San**
6 **Francisco program, for a total term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2030, with one six-**
7 **year option to extend, for a total not to exceed amount of \$41,648,505; and to authorize**
8 **DPH to enter into amendments or modifications to the agreement that do not materially**
9 **increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the**
10 **purposes of the agreement or this Resolution.**

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12 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (DPH) seeks to procure a third-party
13 administrator to pay private network providers for the Healthy San Francisco program; and

14 WHEREAS, The contract is exempt from Civil Service Commission review because it is
15 with a public entity; and

16 WHEREAS, DPH wishes to enter into agreement for a total term of July 1, 2026,
17 through June 30, 2030, with one six-year option to extend, and for a total not to exceed
18 amount of \$41,648,505 (the "Original Agreement"); and

19 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors approval by
20 Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any
21 contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

22 WHEREAS, The proposed agreement contained in File No. 260389, is substantially in
23 final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by
24 the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

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1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the agreement in
2 substantially the form contained in File No. 260389; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes DPH to make any
4 modifications to the agreement, prior to its final execution by all parties, that DPH determines,
5 in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of
6 the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or
7 advisable to effectuate the purposes of the agreement, and are in compliance with all
8 applicable laws, including the City's Charter; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the agreement being fully executed by
10 all parties, DPH shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed
11 copy for inclusion in File No. 260389; this requirement and obligation resides with the
12 Department, and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the
13 validity of approved agreement.
