GGP Tennis - Resurfacing Info

Hi Nicole,

The SF Tennis Coalition has enough money to resurface the two main banks of courts: 6-11 and 12-17. These are in the worst shape and need to be refurbished. The outer courts are in playable condition and can limp into the renovation finish line, unless we can raise the money to resurface all of them.

Cost to resurface 12 courts (6-11 and 12-17): \$45,680

Proposed start date: Sept 7th

Finish date: Sept 17

**Vendor: Vintage Contractors** 

#### What will be done:

- 1. Clean surface and clean out the cracks.
- 2. Apply Plexipave Crackfiller in the cracks.
- 3. Flood and fill water holes deeper than 1/4 inch.
- 4. Apply Resurfacer Course.
- 5. Apply three coats of Plexipave (green and red) and the playing lines.

Note: All cracks will likely reappear immediately. This is an aesthetics and maintenance procedure. It will also be necessary for the City to remove grass and undergrowth from the fence areas before work can be done.

Also: In #4 above, the Resurfacer is a black 100% acrylic base coat used to smooth the existing surface and prepare for the color coating. This will make the surface even and help to hide the patching done in step #2. It will also enhance the surface durability.

We can cover the cost for this procedure - and I have schedule this work to be done starting on Sept 7.

To do 21 courts, we would need to come up with another \$39K.

Please let me know if you have thoughts or questions - and how else we can help. If we get the green light from you, I'd like to discuss how we can parlay this through PR into potential other donations to fund other target courts in the city. Maybe some kind heart will read the PR and chip in to support the other courts SF Tennis Coalition is targeting. That would be fantastic.
