3 **Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Section 10.100-**  
4 **291 to establish the San Francisco Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund to receive donations**  
5 **from employees, and private and public grants and appropriations, gifts and bequests**  
6 **to be used for relief to victim of Hurricane Katrina of 2005.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding  
14 Section 10.100-291, to read as follows:

16 (a) Establishment of Fund. San Francisco Hurricane Katrina Relief Fund is established as  
17 a category four fund for the purpose of receiving donations from employees, private and public grants  
18 and appropriations, gifts and bequests of money and property which may be offered to the City and  
19 County of San Francisco to provide relief from Hurricane Katrina of 2005.

20 (b) Use of Fund. Monies in the fund are to be expended to pay for relief to victims of  
21 Hurricane Katrina, and to pay for costs incurred by the City and County of San Francisco in providing  
22 relief and services to victims of the hurricane. All deposits into the fund shall be subject to the  
23 budgetary and fiscal provisions of the Charter.

24 (c) Administration of Fund. The fund shall be administered by the Controller and will  
25 include monitoring of appropriations from the fund for the relief efforts. The Controller shall not  
release any monies from the Fund without prior approval of the Board of Supervisors for expenditure.

1 The Controller shall submit biannual reports to the Board of Supervisors on expenditure of monies  
2 from this Fund.
