12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	
14	Section 1. Article 4 of the Health Code is hereby amended by adding Section 227, to
15	read as follows:
16	SEC. 227. REPORTS REGARDING DRUG OVERDOSE DEATHS.
17	By no later than the 15th day of each month, the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner shall
18	transmit to the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, and the Director of Health, a report stating the
19	number of individuals whom the Office determined in the preceding calendar month to have died from
20	causes related to overdose of drugs. To the extent possible without disclosing the identity of any
21	decedent or releasing information in violation of any state or federal law, the report shall provide the
22	following information regarding each decedent: the decedent's race, ethnicity, age, and sex; the cause
23	of death; the drug or drugs that contributed to the decedent's death; the calendar month when the
24	decedent died; the San Francisco neighborhood in which the decedent resided, if the decedent was a
25	San Francisco resident; and whether the decedent was homeless.

1	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
