

1 [Declaring August 18, 2000, as "Beniamino 'Benny' Bufano Day"]
2 DECLARING AUGUST 18, 2000, AS "BENIAMINO 'BENNY' BUFANO DAY" IN SAN
3 FRANCISCO

5 WHEREAS, Beniamino "Benny" Bufano, born in San Fele, Italy, in 1898, came to the
6 United States with his immigrant parents in 1902, and first came to San Francisco in 1914 to
7 work as a sculptor for the Panama-Pacific International Exposition of 1915; and,

8 WHEREAS, Bufano adopted San Francisco as his home, and adopted Saint Francis,
9 the patron saint of San Francisco, as the subject of a number of his best-known sculptures;
10 and,

11 WHEREAS, Over 30 of Bufano's works, statues and animal figures presently grace
12 public places in San Francisco - parks, streets, public works projects; and,

13 WHEREAS, His monumental work, "Peace: Mother of All Nations", now on
14 Brotherhood Way, stood for almost 40 years at San Francisco International Airport,
15 welcoming visitors to our City; and

16 WHEREAS, Bufano's bronze and mosaic "St. Francis of the Guns", which now stands
17 at the entrance to City College as a lasting monument against violence, was cast from
18 handguns voluntarily turned in to the City in 1968 after the assassinations of Robert Kennedy
19 and Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

20 WHEREAS, Bufano died in San Francisco on August 18, 1970, and now lies in Holy
21 Cross Cemetery, his burial site marked by one of his marble and mosaic sculptures of his
22 revered St. Francis; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That, in recognizing the 30th anniversary of the death of this much-loved
24 San Francisco sculptor, August 18, 2000, be designated as "BENIAMINO 'BENNY' BUFANO
25 DAY" in San Francisco.


