WHEREAS, The DUI Programs Branch licenses and monitors all DUI programs statewide, establishes regulations, approves participant fees and fee schedules, and provides information and technical assistance; and,

WHEREAS. The objectives of the DUI programs are to: (1) reduce the number of repeat DUI offenses by persons who complete a state-licensed program; and (2) provide participants an opportunity to address problems related to the use of alcohol and/or other drugs; and,

WHEREAS, ADP currently licenses 254 first-offender programs and 234 multipleoffender programs; and.

WHEREAS, Annually, more than 154,000 DUI offenders enroll in California's licensed programs; and,

WHEREAS, Although ADP is responsible for licensing all DUI programs statewide, the licensing process begins with the county Board of Supervisors, which works with the County Alcohol and Drug Program Administrator to recommend applicants to the State for licensure; and.
