

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Police Department to retroactively accept**
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$167,908 from the California Office of Traffic**
5 **Safety (OTS) for an Occupant Protection Program.**

7 WHEREAS, the overall intent of this project is to increase child car seat usage,
8 decrease child car seat misuse and prevent injuries and death to children as a result of motor
9 vehicle collisions; and,

10 WHEREAS, these goals are to be accomplished through an enforcement component
11 and an educational component; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police of the San Francisco Police Department desires to
13 use the grant to fund police operations to accomplish these goals; and,

14 WHEREAS, The grant does not require matching funds; and,

15 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$10,944 now,
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is
18 authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
19 Francisco the attached grant award including any extensions and funding augmentations from
20 the California Office of Traffic Safety, or amendments thereof; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and County of San
22 Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and
23 expend continued funding for this project; and, be it.

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a grant award notification has been received from the
25 California Office of Traffic Safety; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will adhere to the
2 intended use and reporting requirements of the California Office of Traffic Safety regarding the
3 Occupant Protection Program and all conditions specified in the grant agreement; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising out of the
5 performance of this grant award, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
6 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency, and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant funds hereunder shall not be used to supplant
8 expenditures controlled by this body.
