10 service area including fifty percent of the children and youth of San Francisco under the age
11 of eighteen, serving 1,200 children, youth and teens and 100 older adults daily; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Mission YMCA provides much-needed multilingual services to the
13 diverse San Francisco population; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Mission YMCA hosts a variety of resources for older adults through its
15 Senior center, including a hot lunch program and network of professionals providing legal and
16 health care assistance; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Mission YMCA provides affordable pre-school and after school
19 childcare services designed to meet the specific educational and social needs of
20 neighborhood children; and,

21 WHEREAS, In 1998, the Mission YMCA began new programs to serve youth and
22 teens, including participation in the statewide Youth and Government program and programs
23 for gang intervention, middle school students, and gay and lesbian teens; and,


