3	Resolution commending Laura Ware for fourteen years of leadership, commitment, and
4	dedicated service to improving the lives of homeless people in San Francisco.
5	
6	WHEREAS, Laura Ware has spent 17 years working for and with homeless people in
7	San Francisco; and,
8	WHEREAS, Laura Ware co-authored the Coalition of Homelessness (COH) transitional
9	housing study entitled "The Next Step," which led directly to the creation of the Cambridge
10	Hotel Program and the Community Housing Partnership (CHP); and,
11	WHEREAS, Laura Ware is currently the CHP Director of Employment and Training,
12	which provides permanent housing with optional support services to over 300 formerly
13	homeless families and individuals; and,
14	WHEREAS, In large part because of Ware's efforts, over 55% of CHP's staff are
15	formerly homeless people, thus validating the belief that poor and homeless people, with the
16	proper training and support system, can serve their community with great effectiveness; and,
17	WHEREAS, Laura Ware was also the primary architect of the community input process
18	for both the Continuum of Care plans and the HUD McKinney grants for the City;
19	WHEREAS, Ms. Ware worked with the COH and the City to pass San Francisco's local
20	low-income hiring plan on all government contracts; and,
21	WHEREAS, Laura Ware has been a resource to organizations throughout the country
22	who have endeavored to duplicate CHP's strong community commitment in its housing and
23	economic development activities;

1	WHEREAS, Ms. Ware has also served as a member of the COH's Board guiding the
2	development of the organization's structure to ensure that the involvement of homeless
3	people and front-line staff is at the core of all their work; and,
4	WHEREAS, Serving as the Board President for the Central City Hospitality House, Ms.
5	Ware guided the organization through a tough reorganization of their board and instituted the
6	current system of strong community connections and accountability;
7	now therefore, be it,
8	RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commend Laura Ware for
9	fourteen years of leadership, commitment, and dedicated service to improving the lives of
10	homeless people in San Francisco.
