Hi,

I'm a D9 resident and 15-year resident of SF. I'm vehemently against the proposal Supervisor Fielder et al raised to encourage the state to give local control over AVs. Not only should we completely reject it as a city, I'd hope the Board offers a counter-proposal to more-rapidly deploy AVs in critical areas of the city so we can actually save lives.

I used to live on Cortland Ave, on the block where Binod Budhathoki was killed. That kind of reckless driving happens every day on Cortland, especially at night or early morning. Everyone on Cortland has their own story of almost being hit.

That death, and 40,000 more every year in the US, are caused by *human* drivers. Vision Zero has had such little impact because it's working around the margins and not addressing the core problems. Everything in [the Civil Grand Jury report](#) is clear to any SF resident who's ever driven or walked in the city.

AVs don't drive recklessly. As a pedestrian / runner, I feel safe every time I cross the street with a Waymo at the intersection. But I've almost been hit by human drivers more times than I can count. Humans are simply terrible drivers, and we should continue embracing technology to encourage the deployment of both Level 5 AVs and additional automated safety features in human-driven vehicles. After the incident with the N Judah driver falling asleep at the wheel, I wish we'd invest in more autonomous control over MUNI, too.

So I'm angry and frustrated that Supervisor Fielder wants to restrict AVs in San Francisco. It's a performative proposal, unlikely to have any real impact in Sacramento, and it's completely divorced from the reality of traffic safety. You all should do better for your citizens — we simply don't want to die.

Re: Give Communities a Voice on Autonomous Vehicle (AV) Operations

Dear Members of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors:

I am writing to urge you to support local communities' right to vote on whether autonomous vehicles (AVs) should operate in our counties.

With the rise of autonomous vehicles on San Francisco's streets, our community has never been able to voice our concerns about safety, congestion, and accountability, even as AVs become part of our daily lives. Autonomous vehicles have already shown serious operational challenges in San Francisco, causing traffic jams and crashes. This tells many of us that the technology is not yet ready to operate at full scale without stronger local oversight.

Autonomous vehicles have caused congestion on our streets, including traffic jams and crashes. Most notably, during the rainstorm power outage in December 2025, AVs blocked intersections, stalled in the streets, and caused significant road blockages. Since ride-hailing services have already increased traffic in San Francisco, many of us are concerned that AVs will further crowd our streets and make it harder for transit riders, cyclists, and pedestrians to get around safely.

Waymo's own published statistics claim that there have been 81% fewer injury-causing crashes, or 411 fewer crashes, compared to human-operated vehicles. However, many people in our communities believe these statistics should be viewed with caution. AVs have only been on our streets for a relatively short period of time, so we do not yet have a full picture of the real-world risk, as these safety metrics are still emerging.

For these reasons, we strongly ask for your support in passing this item as is, without amendments. This is an essential piece of legislation that will ensure our streets and communities remain protected and that residents have a voice in decisions about AVs in our city.

In the wake of the December power outage that left Waymo vehicles gridlocking traffic across San Francisco, serious public safety questions remain unanswered.

When traffic signals went dark, robotaxis stalled in intersections, blocked roadways, and contributed to citywide congestion, impeding emergency vehicles and creating dangerous conditions for residents. Yet Waymo continues to refuse basic transparency, including:

1. The total size of its active fleet operating on city streets
2. The locations and staffing levels of its remote control call centers
3. Its emergency response and power outage protocols
- 4 .Data on vehicle failures during infrastructure disruptions

In 2024, state legislation that would have granted cities authority to regulate autonomous vehicle deployment was withdrawn after amendments in the Assembly Transportation Committee weakened local control. District 9 Supervisor Jackie Fielder is calling on the state to revive and advance that legislation so cities like San Francisco can exercise democratic oversight over autonomous vehicle operations.

Her colleagues on the Government Audit and Oversight Committee, Daniel Sauter and Stephen Sherrill, have resisted moving this forward.

Our Demands:

Full operational transparency from Waymo regarding fleet size, safety data, and emergency protocols.

Immediate restoration of local regulatory authority over autonomous vehicle deployment.

Mandatory public oversight hearings before any expansion of robotaxi fleets.

Binding emergency coordination standards to ensure autonomous vehicles do not obstruct first responders.

San Francisco's streets are public infrastructure, not a private testing ground. Decisions about their use must be subject to democratic control and public accountability.

Support Supervisor Fielder's resolution and demand that state legislators return regulatory power to our city.
