3	Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of the public sidewalk, subject to
4	Interdepartmental Staff Committee on Traffic and Transportation issuing a permit for
5	each Super Bowl LX related event at the Moscone Center, Grace Cathedral, and the
6	Hibernia, on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from
7	February 1 through February 9, 2026, on both sides of Taylor Street between California
8	Street and Sacramento Street, from 5:00 p.m. on February 5 through 6:00 a.m. on
9	February 7, 2026, on the north side of California Street between Taylor Street and
10	Jones Street, from 6:00 a.m. on February 6 through 6:00 a.m. on February 7, 2026, on
11	the east side of Jones Street from California Street to 225 feet northerly, from 7:00 p.m.
12	on February 5 through 6:00 a.m. on February 7, 2026, and on the south side of
13	Sacramento Street from Taylor Street to 325 feet westerly from 6:00 a.m. on February 6
14	through 6:00 a.m. on February 7, 2026, and on the west side of Jones Street from
15	McAllister Street to 140 feet northerly and on the north side of McAllister Street from
16	Jones Street to 140 feet westerly, from 6:00 a.m. on February 6 through 11:59 p.m. on
17	February 7, 2026.

19	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Article 6 provides for the temporary use and
20	occupancy of a public street for events receiving a permit from the Interdepartmental Staff
21	Committee on Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT); and
22	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Section 6.7, provides that the temporary use or
23	occupancy of a public street shall not unnecessarily obstruct or bar public access onto said
24	street, and that sidewalks shall remain open at all times for pedestrian use unless closure of

1	the sidewalk is provided for by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors explaining the reason
2	for such closure; and
3	WHEREAS, The Super Bowl LX Experience produced by the National Football League in
4	coordination with the Bay Area Host Committee will be held at Moscone Center in early February
5	2026; and
6	WHEREAS, The BAHC Live! Fan Zone produced by the Bay Area Host Committee will
7	be held at Yerba Buena Gardens and the Yerba Buena Center for the Arts in early February
8	2026; and
9	WHEREAS, The Super Bowl LX Experience and BAHC Live! Fan Zone are expected to
10	bring tens of thousands of local, national, and international visitors to the Moscone Center and
11	the surrounding neighborhood over five days; and
12	WHEREAS, An NFL-sanctioned, SEAR 1 event is scheduled to be held at Grace
13	Cathedral on February 6; and
14	WHEREAS, The NFL-sanctioned Taste of the NFL event is scheduled to be held at
15	The Hibernia on February 7; and
16	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks on
17	both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from February 1 through
18	February 9, 2026, is necessary to facilitate the events at the Moscone Center and Yerba
19	Buena Gardens; and
20	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks on
21	both sides of Taylor Street between California Street and Sacramento Street, from 5:00 p.m.
22	on February 5 through 6:00 a.m. on February 7, 2026, on the north side of California Street
23	between Taylor Street and Jones Street, from 6:00 a.m. on February 6 through 6:00 a.m. on
24	February 7, 2026, on the east side of Jones Street from California Street to 225 feet northerly,
25	from 7:00 p.m. on February 5 through 6 am on February 7, 2026, and on the south side of

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalk on the west side of Jones Street from McAllister Street to 140 feet northerly and on the north side of McAllister Street from Jones Street to 140 feet westerly, from 6:00 a.m. on February 6 through 11:59 p.m. on February 7, 2026, is necessary to facilitate the event at The Hibernia; and

WHEREAS, Authorization for the temporary closure of the above sidewalks is subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for each event; and

WHEREAS, This Resolution is not a stand-alone authorization to close the subject sidewalks; any such closures are subject to ISCOTT approving an event permit for each event that authorizes closure of the subject sidewalks and is subject to the City's discretionary adoption of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings for the project, following review and consideration of completed project related environmental analysis, where required; now, therefore, be it
