Resolution urging the Director of Public Health, in consultation with community organizations, to develop a report addressing "Comprehensive Strategies to Serve Homeless Individuals with Mental Health Diagnoses, Substance Abuse Diagnoses and **Chronic Medical Conditions.**"

WHEREAS, Homelessness has a variety of causes; and

WHEREAS, City strategies to deal with homelessness should be tailored to serve different client populations; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health (DPH), through its Community Behavioral Health Services Division and Housing and Urban Health Division, has been working for several years to develop such services, including developing a focus on individuals who are chronically homeless; and

WHEREAS, National homeless policy, including policies being promoted by the federal Interagency Council on Homelessness and various non-profit organizations, is beginning to focus on the chronically homeless, defined as individuals who have been homeless for more than one year and who have a disability; and

WHEREAS, DPH estimates that there are 1,350 chronically homeless San Franciscans who access City services; and

WHEREAS, Many of these individuals receive federal SSI or VA benefits, benefit programs that are not locally controlled; and

WHEREAS, Local non-profit organizations including the Corporation for Supportive Housing and the Mental Health Association of San Francisco have significant expertise that should continue to inform local decision-making; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and the Board of Supervisors should be guided by sound policy advice regarding how best to serve this population and how to minimize the impacts of homelessness on City neighborhoods; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the Director of Public Health, in consultation with the Corporation for Supportive Housing and the Mental Health Association of San Francisco, to develop a report addressing "Comprehensive Strategies to Serve Homeless Individuals with Mental Health Diagnoses, Substance Abuse Diagnoses and Chronic Medical Conditions"; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges DPH, through its

Community Behavioral Health Services Division and and Housing and Urban Health Division,
to seek input from stakeholders and experts, including neighborhood and business
organizations, the Department of Human Services, non-profit service providers, state and
federal representatives, the San Francisco Police Department and others it deems
appropriate to gain input to recommended policies; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the DPH Director's report should include, but not be limited to, the following issues:

- (a) An overview of existing services provided to this client population;
- (b) Recommended additional housing and supportive service programs;
- (c) Federal, state and local funding, including Interagency Council on Homeless grant funding, State of California Multi-Family Housing Program bond funding, and funding for supportive services;
 - (d) Shelter and street outreach, including resident referral;
 - (e) Police crisis intervention training and referrals;

- (f) State and federal lobbying strategies to increase the level of state and federal responsibility for mental health and substance abuse care, including institution of mandated local programs with attached funding streams; and
- (g) Cost-saving estimates of reducing jail and emergency services as a result of program implementation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Director of DPH to circulate his draft report to City groups that assist in the formulation of local homeless policy, including, but not limited to, the Local Homeless Coordinating Board and the Supportive Housing Committee of the Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy Committee and urges the Director of DPH to seek a hearing at the San Francisco Health Commission to obtain public comment on his draft report; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Director of DPH to submit his report to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors by September 1, 2003.
