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3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept		
4	and expend retroactively a grant from the University of Miami in the amount of \$122,160		
5	to perform a randomized clinical trial comparing the relative efficacy and cost-		
6	effectiveness of two HIV testing strategies; for the period of September 30, 2009		
7	through September 29, 2011.		
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9	WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the University of Miami in the amount of		
10	\$122,160 for a project entitled HIV Testing and Counseling in STD Clinics; for the period of		
11	September 30, 2009 through September 29, 2011; and,		
12	WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to perform a randomized controlled clinical		
13	trial comparing the relative efficacy and cost-effectiveness of two HIV testing strategies: (1)		
14	on-site HIV rapid testing with brief, participant-tailored prevention counseling (based on		
15	Project Respect) versus (2) on-site HIV rapid testing with information only (as recommended		
16	in the Centers for Disease Control guidelines); and,		
17	WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for		
18	one existing position: one Senior Physician Specialist, (Job Class 2232) at 0.20 FTE for the		
19	period from September 30, 2009 through September 29, 2011; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of		
21	\$24,299; now, therefore, be it		
22	RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the		
23	amount of \$122,160 from the University of Miami; and, be it		
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1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
2	funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate whe		
3	the agreement expires; and, be it		
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
5	agreement on behalf of the City.
