

1 DESIGNATING TEMPORARY SELLING SPACES IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA AND AT
2 HARVEY MILK PLAZA FOR STREET ARTISTS CERTIFIED BY THE ART COMMISSION,
3 CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, FOR THE WINTER HOLIDAY SEASON,
4 1998, BEGINNING ON NOVEMBER 15, 1998 AND ENDING ON JANUARY 15, 1999

5
6 WHEREAS, The Street Artists Ordinance adopted by the voters
7 on November 4, 1975, authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by
8 resolution, to designate sales areas where any street artist or
9 craftsperson previously certified may sell art or craft items; and

10 WHEREAS, A survey by the Art Commission found that in recent
11 years more street artist spaces in the Downtown area had been
12 eliminated due to construction, curb zone changes, newsracks, planter
13 boxes, etc.; and

14 WHEREAS, The holiday season is the street artists' busiest
15 selling period; and

16 WHEREAS, Last year and the previous fifteen years the Board
17 of Supervisors in Resolutions Nos. 993-97, 1023-96, 922-95, 945-
18 94, 875-93, 994-92, 926-92, 981-91, 863-90, 860-89, 838-88, 1030-
19 87, 935-86, 935-85, 816-84, 960-83, and 916-82 approved temporary
20 selling spaces for the street artists for the winter holiday selling
21 season; and

22 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors in Resolutions Nos. 993-97,
23 1023-96, 922-95, and 1003-92 approved temporary selling spaces for
24 street artists at Harvey Milk Plaza; and

25 WHEREAS, The Art Commission, after conducting a public hearing,
SUPERVISORS TENG, BIERMAN, KATZ, YAKI

1 recommends the renewal of the previous year's temporary sales spaces
2 Downtown and the renewal of the temporary sales spaces at Harvey
3 Milk Plaza; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates the
5 following temporary selling spaces for street artists certified
6 by the Art Commission, for the winter holiday season of 1998
7 beginning on November 15, 1998 and ending on January 15, 1999:

8 Spaces

9 12 - Market Street, south side, 4th to 5th Streets

10 5 - Market Street, north side, Montgomery to Kearny Streets

11 2 - Market Street, north side, Grant to Kearny Streets

12 10 - Market Street, north side, Battery to Sansome Streets

13 5 - Stockton Street, west side, Post to Sutter Streets

14 1 - Stockton Street, east side, Post to Sutter Streets

15 6 - Stockton Street, east side, O'Farrell to Geary Streets

16 3 - Stockton Street, east side, Market to O'Farrell Streets

17 1 - Post Street, south side, Grant to Kearny Streets

18 5 - California Street, north side, Sansome to Montgomery

19 Streets

20 2 - California Street, south side, Sansome to Montgomery

21 Streets

22 3 - Harvey Milk Plaza (upper level)

23 4 - Harvey Milk Plaza (lower level)

24 and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the five (5) temporary spaces on Stockton

1 Street, west side, Post to Sutter Streets, are exempt from the
2 provisions of Police Code Section 2405(c)(8)(1) which prohibits
3 street artists from selling, offering for sale or soliciting offers
4 to purchase on any sidewalk adjacent to a curb which has been
5 designated as a white zone; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the one (1) temporary space on Stockton
7 Street, east side, Post to Sutter Streets, is exempt from the
8 provision of Police Code Section 2405(c)(8)(1); and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the one (1) temporary space on Post
10 Street, south side, Grant to Kearny Streets, is exempt from the
11 provision of Police Code Section 2405(c)(8)(1); and be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That one (1) of the five (5) temporary spaces
13 on Stockton Street, west side, Post to Sutter Streets, is exempt
14 from the provision of Police Code Section 2405(c)(6) which prohibits
15 artists from selling, offering for sale or soliciting offers to
16 purchase on any sidewalk within twelve (12) feet from the outer
17 edge of any entrance to any building including, but not limited
18 to, doors, driveways, emergency exits measured in each direction
19 parallel to the building line and thence at a 90-degree angle to
20 the curb; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That two (2) of the three (3) temporary spaces
22 on Stockton Street, east side, Market to O'Farrell Streets, are
23 exempt from the provision of Police Code Section 2405(c)(6); and
24 be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That five (5) of the twelve (12) temporary

1 spaces on Market Street, south side, 4th to 5th Streets, are exempt
2 from the provision of Police Code Section 2405(c)(6); and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the four (4) spaces in the lower level
4 of Harvey Milk Plaza are exempt from the provision of Police Code
5 Section 2405(c)(6).




