The Projects are or will be owned and/or operated by the Corporation and are located within the geographic boundaries of the City and County of San Francisco (the "City"). The Obligations will be paid enriely from payments by the Corporation under the Loan Agreement. Neither the full faith and credit nor the taxing power, if any, of the City, the Authority and its members, the State of California (the "State") or any other political corporation, subdivision or agency of the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on the Obligations, nor shall the City, the Authority and its members of the principal of the State is pledged to the payment of the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on the Obligations, nor shall the City, the Authority and its members, the State, or any other political corporation, subdivision or agency of the State be liable or obligated to pay the principal of, premium, if any, or interest on the Obligations.

"You can't learn how to code by reading a picture book," he concedes. Stacia Deutsch, who wrote "The Friendship Code" series, had no background in coding when Pengium hirde her to co-write the books in consultation with Saujan's Se she went to after-school coding workshops around Orange County, where she lives, and studied the organization's teaching manual. Using their curriculum, she

focused on a handful of programming concepts and integrated them into

and integrated them into the plot.

The novel centers on a girl named Lucy, who joins an after-school codin golub and starts guiting mysterious noies on her locker. To understand the mes

destand the messages, she has to master odding concepts like input/output, loops and variables. Deutsch struggled at times to get those ideas across. In moments of panic, she called a coder friend for guidance. But in other ways, her satus as a novice was an asset. Her characters did not know much about coding at the beginning of the novel, and noither, she presumes, will many of presumes, will many of

novel, and nother, she presumes, will many of her readers.

"I wanted someone who didn't know any-thing about coding to get excited about the possibil-ities," she said.
